Academic Matters

1. Piloting of Late Start Day on Thursdays

As part of the school's effort to enhance student well-being, the school will be piloting a late start day on Thursdays. Specifically, school start time will be shifted by one hour on Thursdays. There is no change to all other days.

2. Academic Support Programme for Sec 4 & 5

As part of the school's initiative to help students who need additional coaching for their academic subjects, the school has been conducting Academic Support Programme (ASP) on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays after curriculum hours in Semester 1. The ASP aims to help students who need support through remediation on selected topics and/or skills. The ASP will continue in Semester 2.

To support our graduating students in their preparation for the National Examinations, the ASP will start from Term 3 Week 2. The ASP schedule starting Term 3 Week 2 is as follows:

3. Applied Learning Modules at School (ApLM@Schools) for Sec 2 Cohort (Wed, 1 Jul to Fri, 3 Jul)

As part of our school's 4-year Education and Career Guidance (ECG) plan, all Secondary 2 students will participate in ApLM@Schools as part of the 5-day Life Skills Programme in the first week of Term 3. This will take place from Wednesday, 1 July to Friday, 3 July.

ApLM@Schools are enrichment modules that broaden students' learning experiences and complement the secondary school curriculum, with a focus on the practical application of knowledge. These modules provide students with applied learning opportunities—learning that involves doing and applying, learning about the real world, and learning for life. Students will be guided to participate in the modules as part of the programme.



Non-Academic Matters

1. **Sec 2 5-Day Non-Residential Life Skills Camp (Mon, 29 Jun to Fri, 3 Jul)**

As part of our school's student development programme, all Secondary 2 students will participate in a 5-day non-residential Life Skills Camp in Term 3 Week 1. This integrated programme combines a 2-day Outdoor Educational Learning Journey (OELJ) with 3 days of ApLM experiences, providing a coherent and meaningful extension of learning beyond the classroom. Through activities such as team building, outdoor cooking, orienteering, and challenge elements during the OELJ, students will develop resilience, confidence, and leadership. These experiences are further reinforced through the ApLM component, where students deepen their learning and cultivate important dispositions such as curiosity, adaptability, and independence, while taking ownership of their learning through module selection.

2. **Sec 3 MOE Outward Bound School Challenge (Mon, 29 Jun to Fri, 3 Jul)**

Our Secondary 3 students will be participating in the MOE Outward Bound School Challenge (MOC) from Mon, 29 Jun 2026 to Fri, 3 Jul 2026. The MOC experience is designed to develop students' resilience, leadership, and teamwork through authentic outdoor learning. Grounded in experiential education, the programme challenges students to step out of their comfort zones as they engage in a series of land- and sea-based activities that foster confidence, adaptability, and a strong sense of responsibility. Through collaborative tasks and reflection, students learn to communicate effectively, support one another, and demonstrate leadership in unfamiliar environments. The experience also emphasises character development and values such as perseverance and empathy, while deepening students' appreciation of the environment.

3. **Sec 2 Applied Learning Programme (ALP)**

Our school's ALP aims to provide students with authentic opportunities to express themselves creatively and act responsibly through the use of photography and videography. In Term 3, our Sec 2 students will go through cohort-wide trainings to equip them with skills for meaningful application. Our ALP leverages our students' interest in digital content creation to cultivate deeper learning beyond technical skill. It develops their ability to harness technology responsibly and work with determination as they plan, film, and edit their own media narratives. Through purposeful storytelling, students also explore how media can be a powerful platform for empathy, advocacy, and social good. In doing so, it strengthens their 21st Century Competencies in critical and inventive thinking, communication and collaboration, and civic literacy. For those with a keen interest in digital media, the school offers additional opportunities through the Digital Media in Visual Arts Club.

4. Student Leadership Development Programme

As part of the school's Student Leadership Development Programme (SLDP), student leaders from Secondary 1 to 3 will continue their leadership journey in Semester 2. Grounded in the Leadership Challenge Model, the programme develops Class Leaders, CCA Leaders, Student Councillors, and Peer Support Leaders (PSLs) to serve with humility, lead with confidence, and inspire meaningful change.

Through purposeful learning experiences, students will build key skills such as communication, collaboration, empathy, and responsible decision-making, while contributing to student voice, school spirit, and peer well-being. They will also take on leadership roles in school-wide events, including National Day, Teachers' Day, and the Secondary 1 Orientation in 2027.

PSLs will undergo specialised training to strengthen skills in active listening, confidence, and servant leadership, and will lead initiatives such as Termly Birthday Celebrations, Youth Day (Term 3), and Wellness Week (Term 4), fostering a culture of care within the school community.

5. Sec 1 Conversational Chinese & Malay Programme

The Conversational Chinese & Malay Language (CCM) Programme aims to strengthen Singapore's multi-racial compact by equipping students with functional Chinese and Malay language skills for meaningful engagement within the country and region. Through a structured language exchange, students taking Malay Language will learn conversational Chinese, while those taking Chinese Language will learn conversational Malay; students not offering a Mother Tongue Language, as well as those taking Tamil, will learn Malay. The programme comprises five sessions held on Thursdays, focusing on developing students' ability to communicate in everyday situations through listening and speaking, participate in conversations, and understand verbal narratives, while gaining deeper appreciation of Chinese and Malay cultures.

As part of the post-examination programme for all Secondary 1 students, learning is further enriched through authentic experiences during visits to Chinatown and Kampung Glam, where students practise the language in real-life contexts. Students will also record, edit, and present videos of their language use, allowing them to apply and extend skills developed in their previous ALP experience.

6. Sec 1 Code for Fun (CFF) and Sec 2 Artificial Intelligence (AI) For Fun Programme

To enhance students' digital competencies and interest in coding and programming, our Secondary 1 students will be embarking on a 10-hour Code For Fun (CFF) Programme that will expose them to computational thinking skills and emerging technologies in Term 4:

Through the programme, students will learn about coding and develop an interest in technology, honing their ability to innovate and problem-solve. Our Secondary 2 students will build on their CFF knowledge from Secondary 1 and embark on the new Artificial Intelligence (AI) For Fun programme. With the advancements in AI technology, our students will learn how to utilise AI to help them with coding and digital making.

7. Sec 2 & 3 Overseas Learning Journey – Malaysia, Thailand, Taiwan & Guangzhou, China

As part of our commitment to providing holistic educational experiences, all Secondary 2 students will be invited to participate in a 2D1N Overseas Learning Journey (OLJ) to Johor and Malacca, Malaysia, after the last day of school on Fri, 23 October (Term 4). As the OLJ takes place during the school holidays, students will attend one of the two trips: 26–27 October 2026 (Trip 1) and 28–29 October 2026 (Trip 2).

Selected Secondary 3 students will participate in their respective OLJs to Taiwan and Guangzhou, China from 12–16 October 2026. These journeys aim to deepen students' global awareness and cross-cultural competencies through authentic learning experiences. Students' safety remains our top priority, and a parent briefing will be conducted closer to the departure dates.

The NYAA aims to develop and maximise the potential of young people's potential through three key areas: Service Learning, Outdoor Appreciation and Healthy Living and Community Leadership Initiative. This programme helps nurture exceptional individuals who can contribute effectively to society and the nation. All Secondary 1 and 3 students have been successfully registered with the NYAA Council.

2. National Day Celebrations 2026 (Fri, 7 Aug)

This year's theme, "*Majulah Singapura, Go Beyond!*", reflects our Singapore Spirit and our enduring aspiration to keep moving forward as a nation. It is also a call to action for all Singaporeans to go beyond—striving to do better for one another and showing care and concern for our community. As we mark 61 years of independence, the theme encourages students to reflect on our shared journey and to play their part in building a stronger, more caring Singapore.
